By faith Abraham, when God tested him, offered Isaac as a sacrifice. He who had received the promises was about to sacrifice his one and only son, even though God had said to him, "It is through Isaac that your offspring will be reckoned." Abraham reasoned that God could raise the dead, and figuratively speaking, he did receive Isaac back from death. Hebrews 11:17-19 (NIV)

• **Abraham and Sarah _____ with God**

By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, obeyed and went, even though he did not know where he was going. Hebrews 11:8 (NIV)

So Abram left, as the LORD had told him; and Lot went with him. Abram was seventy-five years old when he set out from Haran. Genesis 12:4 (NIV)

• **Abraham and Sarah were _____ to God's Will**

By faith he made his home in the promised land like a stranger in a foreign country; he lived in tents, as did Isaac and Jacob, who were heirs with him of the same promise. Hebrews 11:9 (NIV)

This is love for God: to obey His commands. And His commands are not burdensome. 1 John 5:3 (NIV)

• **Abraham and Sarah did trust God's _____ ...eventually**

By faith Abraham, even though he was past age—and Sarah herself was barren—was enabled to become a father because he considered Him faithful who had made the promise. Hebrews 11:11 (NIV)

What does the Scripture say? "Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness." Romans 4:3 (NIV)

• **Abraham and Sarah took God _____**

By faith Abraham, when God tested him, offered Isaac as a sacrifice. Hebrews 11:17 (NIV)

This is why "it was credited to him as righteousness." The words "it was credited to him" were written not for him alone, but also for us, to whom God will credit righteousness—for us who believe in Him who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead. He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification. Romans 4:22-25 (NIV)
