Dr. Doug Carver Chaplain (Major General), USA, Ret. Executive Director of Chaplaincy North American Mission Board, Southern Baptist Convention

General Carver served at every level of the Army, from platoon to the Department of the Army Staff, during

his distinguished thirty-eight years of military service as a commissioned officer. Prior to joining the North American Mission Board, he was appointed by President George W. Bush as the United States Army's 22nd Chief of Chaplains (2007-2011).

An ordained Southern Baptist minister, he has pastored churches in Colorado, Kentucky, North Carolina, and Virginia. He currently serves as an Adjunct Faculty Mentor for Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary.
