

## **CAMP 2024**

### BEFORE

**Supervise Packing:** Know what your student is taking. Use this time to coach them through decisions of clothing, electronics, and anything that may be inappropriate for the trip. There will be **NO CELL PHONES ALLOWED** at camp.

**Expectations:** Talk clearly about the expectations you have for them at Camp Ocoee - behavior, attitude, respect for authority, and focus. The less time we spend dealing with "drama", the more time for ministry and fun!

### DURING

**Get Started Well!** Be sure to arrive on time on Tuesday, June 11th. We are asking everyone to be here at 12:30PM. It feels good to arrive with plenty of time to get final registration completed, say goodbyes, and not be rushed.

- What effect can you have in your school?
- How can I help you with what God taught you this last week.

## WHAT TO BRING

### **Backpack & Luggage**

Both backpack and luggage should be labeled with Student Name Luggage should be one duffle bag OR one small/medium suitcase You will NOT be able to get into your luggage during travel (PLAN AHEAD – medications, snacks, jackets, etc.)

### **Shirts**

- If you are wearing an oversized shirt make sure we can see your shorts/pants

#### **Pants**

- No short shorts (at least 4" shorts)
- Nothing see-thru (white is a dangerous color)

#### **Swimwear**

- Modest One-Piece Swimsuit (full coverage & no cut outs)
- Tankini (If you have to wear a two piece, you must have a dark colored shirt over it.)
- Please wear a cover-up or t-shirt to & from the water

### **Shirts**

### Swimwear

- Modest trunk-style swimsuit.
- Please wear a tshirt to & from the water
