DEFORE

Supervise Packing: Know what your student is taking. Use this time to coach them through decisions of clothing, electronics, and anything that may be inappropriate for the trip. There will be **NO CELL PHONES ALLOWED** at camp.

Expectations: Talk clearly about the expectations you have for them at Camp Shocco - behavior, attitude, respect for authority, and focus. The less time we spend dealing with "drama", the more time for ministry and fun!



Get Started Well! Be sure to arrive on time on Friday, June 28th. We are asking everyone to be here at 2:00PM. It feels good to arrive with plenty of time to get final registration completed, say goodbyes, and not be rushed.

Pray: Please PRAY with us over our times of travel, Bible Study, fellowship, recreation and most importantly, worship.

- Did you make any commitments to yourself or God at Camp Shocco?
- · What effect can you have in your school?
- How can I help you with what God taught you this last week?

Know that we value what you are doing as a parent. Thank you for the opportunity to join you in the discipleship of your student. Please let us know if we can continue to help you out!

CAMP RULES

- 1. Please, no public displays of affection during camp. There will be no guys in girls' cabins, and no girls in guys' cabins.
- 2. No Pranks.
- 3. Respect other peoples belongings.
- 4. No Alcohol, Tobacco, Drugs, Fireworks, Vapes.
- 5. LIGHTS OUT means all rooms must turn all lights out and be quiet. Changing clothes, brushing teeth and getting ready for bed must be done BEFORE lights out.


